### Kia ora!

<u>Te Hononga Akoranga COMET</u> invites your intermediate/secondary school to design the cover of our 2022 Annual Report.

All students aged from 11 years to 18 years of age are encouraged to design an artwork that reflects our vision 'tino rangatiratanga for everyone, through lifelong learning'. The winning entry will best reflect this in their artwork.

Artists are invited to submit their artwork for the 2022 Te Hononga Akoranga COMET Annual Report cover and the winning artwork will be used to create the front and back cover of the report which is distributed to our important stakeholders.

The winner will receive a \$100.00 gift card for their entry and their school art department will receive a \$200.00 gift card to purchase artwork supplies. The artist will also receive a credit and a photo in the front inside cover of the Annual Report.

All entries must be accompanied by a signed and completed Entry Form including design story by 5 pm on 29 July 2022. Entry limit of one entry per artist and no late entries will be considered.

## Terms and Conditions:

- 1. The artwork must reflect Te Hononga Akoranga COMET's vision: 'tino rangatiratanga for everyone, through lifelong learning'
- 2. All participating artists must be aged between 11 years 18 years; participating Artist under 18 years must have a parent/guardian's permission to enter the competition.
- 3. All entries will be viewed by and judged by a panel of Te Hononga Akoranga COMET communications and design team, including our Chief Executive Susan Warren. The judges decision is final and correspondence will not be entered into.

The artist is to submit only one artwork entry via email to <u>rajshree.krishnan@cometauckland.org.nz</u> accompanied by a signed Entry Form and Artwork Competition Consent with an attached digital photo of the artwork and a photograph of yourself.

- 4. The winning artist acknowledges their artwork will be copied and reproduced for the purposes of Te Hononga Akoranga COMET's Annual Report for 2022, this also potentially includes other sections of the report. It will also be used for the promotion of the Annual Report and relative programs throughout the period the Annual Report is valid. The winning artist will be required to supply an original copy of their design for reproduction by 5pm on 29 July 2022.
- 5. No group entries will be accepted.
- 6. The artwork format and size include:

Formats: JPEG, TIFF, PSD, RAW

**Size**: Minimum size requirements (220mm x 310mm, portrait, 300dpi). Must be portrait orientated and photographed for a high-quality output.

**Avoid**: Do not submit the image in a Word, PowerPoint, or any other application document. The original final digital version of the work must be sent on request.

- 7. The original artwork will be retained by Te Hononga Akoranga COMET and hung or placed in the head office.
- 8. All participating artists warrant that they are 11 years or older at the time the Entry Form is submitted; the artwork submitted is original work; the artwork submitted has not been the recipient of a major prize before; and that they have not charged or otherwise encumbered the work nor given any assignment inconsistent with these Terms and Conditions. Where a participating artist is under the age of 18, the artist's adult parent/ guardian must sign the Entry Form to give permission on behalf of the artist.
- 9. An award of \$100.00 gift card for the individual and \$200.00 gift card for the school the artist attends to purchase art supplies will be awarded at the completion of the competition.

- 10. Property rights in all submissions, including the winning artwork, will remain the artist's except as provided by these Terms and Conditions.
- 11. By signing a completed Entry Form, submitting an artwork, and accepting the award offer, the winning artist: grants Te Hononga Akoranga COMET a permanent, royalty-free, worldwide, irrevocable, ongoing, non-exclusive license (including a right of sub-license to use, reproduce, distribute, adapt, modify the winning artwork in all media of expression now known or later developed for the purpose or any other purpose associated with Te Hononga Akoranga COMET. This also includes but not limited to, reproducing, and publishing the winning entry of the official 2021 Annual Report com- petition, as the cover of the Annual Report, inside the report and for any other event, educational purpose, or activity.
- 12. All entries must be received by 5 pm on 29 July 2022
- 13. If, for any reason, the competition is not able to be run as planned Te Hononga Akoranga COMET may cancel the Annual Report competition without liability to any entrant, or any other person.
- 14. Te Hononga Akoranga COMET is the Promoter of the Annual Report competition for 2022.
- 15. Te Hononga Akoranga COMET reserves the right, at any time, to verify the validity of participating artist, artwork, and Entry Form (including participating artist's identity, age and place of residence) and to disqualify a participating artist who submits an Entry Form that is not in accordance with these Competition Terms and Conditions or who tampers with the entry process.
